- What did David have to believe for this to be true?
- What did David need to do for this to be true?

Do you think God is with us in the bad as well as the good?

- What does that look like to you?
- Are bad days curses or opportunities?

As David and his men experienced an “aha” moment:

- How did this change the trajectory of the story?
- When has this been true of you?

God is not satisfied with you being a petite cottage but is in fact remodeling you into a palace He wants to live in with you.

- How is the renovation going?
- What have been some of the growing pains?
- What have you noticed that is different today as opposed to last year?
